Supply	Brand Preference	Quantity/Details
Graphite Pencil Set or purchase individual pencils "open stock"	Staedtler, Derwent good But buy any in your price range	1 set At least these: 2H, HB, 2B, 4B, 6B
Colored Pencil Set	Prismacolor best but buy in your price range. Do not recommend Michael's house brand (Artist Loft)	At least 12 colors in set, 24 better
Stick Chalk Pastel Set	Prismacolor NuPastel Brand or any other "hard pastel stick"	At least 12 colors in set, 24 better
Oil Pastel Set	Crayola or Cray-Pas make a nice set but buy in your price range.	At least 12 colors in set, 24 better
Watercolor Pencil Set	Any brand in your price range. Crayola is surprisingly good	At least 12 colors in set, 24 better
Charcoal/Conte Pencils	Open Stock or set	Should include black, white, sanguine
Vine Charcoal	Used for Sketching- any brand in your price range	Usually comes in pack
Permanent Pens	Sharpie or any brand in your price range	Fine Point, Extra Fine Point
Kneaded Eraser	One for pastel work, one for other media	2
White Plastic Eraser	Staedtler or other brand	1
Tortillon or Stump	Used for smudging dry media	1-2 of different sizes
Drawing Pad or Sketchbook	Canson or Strathmore Brand or any in your price range	Look for one that says for "mixed media"-for practice and studies
Bristol Paper Pad	For more finished work	9x12 or 11x14
Pastel/ Charcoal Paper	Toned paper best (greys etc.) Often come in mixed pack.	At least 11x14
